3.0 QUALIFICATION AND EXPERIENCE CRITERIA:

- a) Bidder should have minimum 08 years of same experience.
- b) Bidder must have prepared at least 3 Biodiversity Impact Assessment Report / Wildlife Conservation Plan, out of them at least one for Government Organizations / PSU's etc.
- c) Bidder ensure that Qualified Staff at least Post graduate in Environmental Science or Zoology / Botany or equivalent and above, should only be engaged for preparation of conservation plan on the said five projects of GMDC.
- d) Annual turnover of the company should not be less than 25 Lakhs in last three years.

4.0 SCOPE OF WORK:

[I] SCOPE OF BIDDER:

“Study and Preparation of Conservation Plan for Avian Fauna and Protected / Endangered Animal Species along with Fauna found in and around of the GMDC Mining Projects in consultation with State Forest & Wildlife Department”. Detail of work is as below:

1. Organize field work, data collection, meeting with concerned government line departments, and engage competent professionals for conducting field work to collect data for preparation of Biodiversity Conservation Plan
2. Involve community through Focus Group Discussion to understand their views and assess the Biodiversity Conservation options.
3. Submit the final Biodiversity Conservation Plan.

GMDC reserves the right to reject any or all the tenders or split the work between more than one bidder without assigning any reason thereof and volume of work can also be reduced any time before or during the execution of work.

Tenderer shall not be responsible to provide lodging/boarding to the successful bidder but can provide on chargeable basis as when and where available.

[III] SCOPE, AIMS AND OBJECTIVES:

- i) A detailed biological study of the study area [core zone and buffer zone (10 km radius of the periphery of the mine lease)] should be carried out. Details of flora and fauna should be collected based on primary field survey and secondary sources.
- ii) The Species selected for green belt should be prescribed in consultation with the local forest department.
- iii) Measures to be taken for protection of water stream passing through the mine lease area will be mentioned.

Assessment of Flora and Fauna:

- Assessment of Major floral and faunal components of all the terrestrial habitats within the core zone and buffer zone (10 kms. radius).
- Collection of Secondary information on the status of floral and faunal components and habitats from the concerned stakeholders, Forest Department and published sources.
- Identification and listing of species of conservation significance (Rare, Endangered, Endemic and Threatened – REET species in accordance with IUCN, WCMC, BSL ZSI, WPA 1972 and Birdlife international in the core and buffer zone will be made.
- Identification of ecologically sensitive areas (Protected Areas: Sanctuary, National Parks, Biosphere Reserve, Wildlife corridors) existing in the vicinity of the (within 10 km radius).

Flora

Taxonomical status

- Species diversity, density, distribution, frequency and abundance life form status should be done.
- Preparation of overall list of plant species based on the sample survey and secondary information.

Fauna

Taxonomical status

- Compilation and preparation of Faunal inventory in the study based on secondary sources and primary data.

Since the study will be made in one season only and within a limited period the data can be collected mostly based on the secondary sources and oral history of reported sighting of animals in consultation with the villagers and the indirect evidences.

Threatened Species

- Listing of threatened floral species.
- Listing of threatened faunal species.

Biodiversity and Wildlife Conservation and Management Plan

- Conservation and management plan shall be prepared to improve the habitat quality of the study area to enhance the overall biological diversity.
- Application of GIS tools to identify the habitats, all the primary data collected shall be geo referenced.
- Conservation and management plan for species of conservation significance especially Schedule I of WPA reported from the study area shall be prepared.
- Measures for protection and conservation of wildlife species shall be suggested and be indicated in the maps.

5.0 Timelines of work: 8 months

6.0 Bids complete in all respect will be received by Chief General Manager at the above address. Bidder may carry out entire work in a manner to satisfy needs of the GMDC & GPCB in all respect. Bidder will abide by statutory regulations applicable at the project e.g. Mines Act, Factory Act and other related Law & Regulations etc.

7.0 TERMS OF PAYMENT:

Payment will be release on monthly basis after receipt of followings:

- 30% of individual project wise costs after initiating work on individual projects.
- 40% of individual project wise cost after receipt of draft reports of individual projects.
- 30% of cost after receipt of final reports of all the projects and their certifications from Gujarat State Forest & Wildlife Department.

8.0 TAXES, DUTIES & LEVIES AND STATUTORY OBLIGATIONS:

All applicable taxes and duties etc. will be reimbursed after receipt of documentary proof of its submission to regulatory body. TDS will be deducted as per rule.

9.0 SUBLETTING OF THE WORK:

Successful Bidder will not sublet the work or any part of it to any other agency.

10.0 TENDER FEE AND EARNEST MONEY DEPOSIT:

- (a) A non-interest bearing DD of **TENDER Fee** of Rs. **1000/- (One Thousand only)** and **Earnest Money Deposit** of **Rs. 48,000/- (Rs. Forty Eight Thousand Only)** shall be submitted along with desired form provided with tender in separate sealed cover super scribed "**TENDER / EMD Fee**" in favour of **GMDC Ltd. payable at Ahmedabad**. Any pending dues against invoice or any other deposit lying with the GMDC will not be adjusted against Earnest Money Deposit. Any Tender submitted without Earnest Money shall be summarily rejected and no claim shall be entertained on such rejected tenders.
- (b) The unsuccessful bidders will be refunded the only EMD amount by way of crossed cheque at earlier after receipt of written request for EMD refund.
- (c) Tender Fee is non refundable and EMD of successful bidder will be adjusted in Security Deposit that will released after satisfactory completion of contract.
- (d) If the party does not accept the work order issued by GMDC, then EMD amount paid by the bidder will be forfeited.

11.0 SECURITY DEPOSIT:

The successful Bidder shall have to pay Security Deposit @ 5% of the total contract value of all the five projects (Including EMD) within a fortnight after receipt of the order by way

1. DD in favour of GMDC Ltd. payable at Ahmedabad **or**
2. Bank Guarantee, issued by Nationalised or bank approved by GoG (except Co-op Bank) only in India valid for a period of not less than 3 (three) months beyond the proposed validity of bid. Further Bank Guarantee will be extended from time to time as per requirement of GMDC.

If the successful bidder does not pay security deposit or does not carry out the job assigned as per our order or does not fulfill any of the terms & conditions of this tender, Earnest money deposit/ Security Deposit paid by such bidder shall be liable to be forfeited.

Security Deposit paid will be refunded within 3 months after the completion of the work satisfactorily and receipt of written request from successful bidder.

Earnest Money/Security Deposit will not bear any interest.

12.0 NO RELAXATION OF EMD/SD.

No relaxation will be here for EMD / SD.

13.0 ACCEPTANCE OF LOI:

If the successful bidder does not accept the Letter of Intent issued by GMDC as per the requirement of LOI, the EMD paid by him will be forfeited.

The order will be awarded to the technically and commercially qualified and responsive Successful Bidder, who bid in conformity of the requirement of the specifications of the document. A responsive Bid is one which accepts all the terms and conditions of the specifications and documents without any modification.

14.0 STATUTORY OBLIGATIONS:

- a) The Bidder shall be responsible for arranging requisite manpower, and shall also fulfil the provisions of Labour laws Labour Laws etc., pertaining to employment of labour and other statutes in force from time to time.
- b) If any amount becomes payable by GMDC as a result of any claim or application due to non compliance of the provision of any Act or Rule or Regulations, By-laws or the Orders made there under, applicable from time to time , such amounts shall be recoverable from the successful bidder.
- c) The selected successful bidder shall indemnify GMDC against any claim, compensation, damage, loss, penalty etc. for breach and / or non-fulfilment of the prevailing Rules and Regulations and other statutory provisions in force from time to time and applicable to the work during the currency of contract. Statutory Obligations:

15.0 LIQUIDATED DAMAGES:

Successful bidder shall be responsible for monthly environmental monitoring and analysis of various GMDC projects in Gujarat as specified / described under the scope of work in this tender and technical document in accordance with sound and established practices, regulations applicable, for the purpose(s) specified, free from defects and suitable for respective uses intended.

The cumulative limit of successful bidder's liabilities under the TENDER, for all guarantees or warranties of whatever nature, whether expressed or implied and all causes whatsoever including liquidated damages for delay and or non performance shall be limited to 5% of CONTRACT charges / remuneration.

16.0 ACCEPTANCE OF GENERAL TERMS & CONDITIONS:

The bidder should unconditionally accept all the terms and conditions of the contract by signing & stamping on each page of the bid document of the tender including the annexure.

17.0 BLACK LISTING OF THE BIDDER:

The Bidder or its directors should not have been black listed / terminated by any Government Organization, or any litigation be pending against any of them. The bidder will submit declaration to this effect along with the technical bid. If at any time such declaration is found false, the bid will be rejected or if the contract work is already awarded, it will be terminated forthwith without payment of any compensation and the EMD/SD will be forfeited.

18.0 NON FULL FILAMENT OF TERMS & CONDITIONS & TERMINATION OF THE CONTRACT:

If the successful bidder fails to carry out the work as per terms and conditions of the contract to the satisfaction of GMDC, GMDC shall be entitled to terminate the contract and forfeit the EMD / Security Deposit paid by the successful bidder.

If required, for any reason, GMDC reserves right to cancel, terminate, amend and / or alter the contract and / or bifurcate and / or reduce the contract work at any time without giving any notice to the bidder without incurring any responsibility.

19.0 DISPUTES:

The Court at Ahmedabad in Gujarat State only will have jurisdiction to deal with and decide any legal dispute or contravention between the parties hereto.

20.0 FORCE MAJEURE:

Force majeure is here in defined as natural phenomena such as floods, cyclone, earthquakes and epidemics, declaration of war, accidents etc. In such conditions of force majeure both the parties can claim force majeure but they are obliged to inform the either party within 7 days in writing of the date of commencing and again ending of the force majeure. Under the circumstances of force majeure, the contract period for starting work shall be extended by period equivalent to the loss of time due to force majeure. However no other relaxation can be given. Further if any circumstances of force majeure will occur during harvesting period, the loss time equivalent to the loss due to force majeure will be extended.

The decision regarding the occurrence of force majeure to be considered shall be taken jointly by Successful bidder and **GMDC**.
