### 3.0 SCOPE OF WORK

The mine plan shall be prepared by qualify mining Engineer or Geologist as per section 15 (A) of the MCR - 2016

The modified mine plan including mine closure plan shall be prepared to explore the available mineable reserve of the area by open cast method so as to ensure conservation of mineral wealth.

While preparing the mining plan / modified mining plan, other conditions of the lease approval / block allotment etc shall be strictly followed.

Mining plan / Modified mining plan & associated drawings / plates shall be prepared using latest software.

Mining plan / Modified mining plan including mine closure plan shall be prepared as per current guideline of the IBM. If IBM publishes any amendment during course of mine plan / mining scheme preparation, successful bidder has to also incorporate the same in mine plan / mining scheme

**7) OPENING OF BIDS**

- b. Preliminary bids will be opened after verification of receipt of payment towards Tender Fee and EMD. The bidders will be able to view it on their computers on date and time notified in tender notice.
- c. On verification of the supporting documents, technical qualification of the bidders will be assessed. The successful bidders will be communicated the date and time of on line opening of price bids by fax or telephone or email or SMS. **8) CORRIGENDUM**

**9) Earnest Money Deposit :**

- (a) A non-interest bearing Earnest Money Deposit of Rs. 1 lakh shall be paid along with the tender, enclosed with **TECHNICAL BID** documents in seal cover super scribed "**TECHNICAL BID COVER**", in form of Demand Draft drawn in favour of GMDC Ltd. payable at Ahmedabad from any Nationalised or scheduled banks (not being a cooperative Bank), or

Bank Guarantee, issued by a Nationalised or IDBI, ICICI, Axis, HDFC banks only in India valid for a period of not less than 3 (three) months beyond the proposed validity of bid

- (b) Any pending dues against invoice or any other deposit lying with the GMDC will not be adjusted against Earnest Money Deposit Any tender submitted without Earnest Money shall be summarily rejected and no claim shall be entertained on such rejected tenders.
- (c) The unsuccessful bidders will be refunded the EMD amount by way of crossed cheque within 15 days of finalization of the tender,

**10) Security Deposit :**

The successful bidder shall have to deposit Security Deposit at 10% of the order value (Including EMD) within a fortnight after receipt of the order by the following way

1. DD in favour of GMDC Ltd. payable at Ahmedabad from any nationalised or scheduled banks (not being a cooperative Bank), or

## **11) RATES:**

- c) Bidders are requested to quote there rates without GST, applicable GST will be reimbursed to the successful bidder as per prevailing rates & rules subject to production of documentary proof and bidder should mention the GST amount separately in the invoice /bill along with SAC/HSN code under GST
- d) Bidders , who are opting for composite scheme under GST, are required to quote there rates inclusive of GST
- e) However such duties, taxes, levies etc. which is notified after the last date of submission of tender and/or any increase over the rate existing

on the last date of submission of tender shall be reimbursed by the GMDC on production of documentary evidence in support of payment actually made to the concerned authorities.

- f) GMDC reserves the right to accept or overlook or rejecting any lower rates offered by the bidder without assigning any reason thereof The evaluation of offers will be made on the basis of the lowest offer , Technical skill , available software , Experience and financial position of the bidder.
- g) The bidder is required to quote the rate strictly as per the terms and conditions mentioned in the tender documents. **The conditional tender will not be entertained and will be rejected.** The rate quoted should be inclusive of all items.

#### **11- A) PENALTY**

If the successful bidder fails to start the work within 10 days of receipt of LOI, then GMDC can forfeit the EMD and shall be free to have the work executed through third party at the risk and cost of the successful bidder. GMDC will impose penalty @ of 0.5% of the total contract value of the work per week of delay or part thereof subject to a ceiling of 10% of the total contract value of the work.

**If the consultant will fail to submit the Draft / final report to IBM within stipulated time period , GMDC will cancel the work order and forfeit the EMD / SD.**

#### **12) ACCEPTANCE OF GENERAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS:**

The bidder shall unconditionally accept all the terms and conditions of the tender and subsequent. The bidder shall also sign on each page of the technical bid document of the tender including the annexures.

#### **13) ACCEPTANCE OF LOI :**

If the successful bidder does not accept the Letter of Intent or work order issued by GMDC within one week of its receipt, the EMD paid by him shall be forfeited.

**14) CONTRACT AGREEMENT:**

The successful bidder will have to enter into an agreement within 10 (Ten) days of the receipt of LOI, with GMDC on appropriate Stamp Paper (to be provided by the successful bidder) in token of acceptance of the terms and conditions of the contract. In case of failure, the contract is liable to be terminated and the Security deposit / EMD may be forfeited.

**15) COMMENCEMENT OF WORK:**

The successful bidder will have to start the work within 10 (ten) days of the date of receipt of the Letter of Intent.

If the successful bidder fails to start the work within 15 days of receipt of LOI, then GMDC can forfeit the EMD and shall be free to have the work executed through third party at the risk and cost of the successful bidder.

**16) DURATION AND QUANTITY OF WORK**

The period of the contract will be four months starting the date of commencement of the work.

**17) LOCAL FACILITIES / LOCAL CONDITIONS**

GMDC do not undertake or agree to provide any facilities to the successful bidder at the work site. However, the successful bidder has to make his own independent arrangements for Tools, tackles, machinery, equipment, etc. and the manpower required to execute the contract shall be arranged by the successful bidder only.

**17-A) Obligation of GMDC :**

GMDC will provide

- Copy of the previous approved mine plan if available
- Geological / exploration / analysis data
- Latest Surface plan and DGPS survey plan (If available)
- Proposed production schedule

**18) REPORTS :-**

All the draft reports shall be to be submitted in duplicate .

GMDC after scrutiny of the draft report return it back to successful bidder and thereafter the required number of final report is to be submitted by consultant to IBM through GMDC

In case Indian Bureau of Mines raises any queries or directs any rectifications or modifications, the successful bidder shall comply and submit all relevant document as per the comment of IBM within due time limit.

The successful bidder shall get the submitted report / scheme approved by IBM within next one month

The successful bidder shall have to submit 5 copies of the approved report (Drawing and text) along with a Soft Copy (in CD/DVD form ) to GMDC

If required successful bidder have to make power point presentation to GMDC before submission of mine plan / mining scheme to IBM

**20) STATUTORY OBLIGATIONS:**

- a) The Contractor shall be responsible for arranging requisite manpower, and shall also fulfill the provisions of Labour laws, PF Act and Rules, Contract Labour Laws etc., pertaining to employment of labour and other statutes in force from time to time.
- b) If any amount becomes payable by GMDC as a result of any claim or application due to non compliance of the provision of any Act or Rule or Regulations, By-laws or the Orders made there under, applicable from time to time, on account of successful bidder such amounts shall be recoverable from the successful bidder.
- f) The selected successful bidder shall indemnify GMDC against any claim, compensation, damage, loss, penalty etc. for breach and / or non-fulfillment of the prevailing Rules and Regulations and other statutory provisions in force from time to time and applicable to the work during the currency of contract.

**21) LIQUIDATED DAMAGES & PENALTY**

If the successful bidder fails to start the work within 15 days of receipt of LOI, then GMDC can forfeit the EMD and shall be free to have the work executed through third party at the risk and cost of the successful bidder.

The Owner shall levy Penalty at the rate of 0.5% of the total contract value of the work ( For each mine plan /mining scheme) per week of delay or part thereof subject to a ceiling of 10% of the total contract value of the work.

If consultant/ Bidder fails to prepare and submit the draft mining plan to IBM within stipulated time as per point no 16, GMDC shall cancel the work order and forfeit the EMD/SD submitted by consultant / bidder

**22) BLACK-LISTING OF THE BIDDER:**

The Bidder or its directors or partners should not have been black listed by any Government Organisation, or any litigation be pending against any of them. The bidder will submit declaration to this effect along with the technical bid. If at any time such declaration is found false, the bid will be rejected or if the contract work is already awarded, it will be terminated forthwith without payment of any compensation and the EMD/SD will be forfeited.

**23) NON FULFILMENT OF TERMS & CONDITION AND TERMINATION OF THE CONTRACT.**

If the successful bidder fails to carry out the work as per terms and conditions of the contract to the satisfaction of GMDC, GMDC shall be entitled to terminate the contract and forfeit the security deposit paid by the successful bidder. This however, shall not absolve the successful bidder from his obligation to fulfill the contract. In such event, GMDC shall have the right to complete and / or to get the work completed at the cost & risk of the Successful bidder.

Likewise, if the successful bidder does not fulfill the terms and conditions of the contract and does not carry out the work up to the entire satisfaction of GMDC, GMDC has the right to forthwith terminate the contract at its sole discretion, without assigning any reason, Under such events, GMDC shall be entitled to forfeit the security deposit paid by the Contractor and GMDC shall have a right to complete the work and / or to get the work completed at the risk and cost of the Successful bidder.

If required, for any reason, GMDC reserves right to cancel, terminate, amend and / or alter the contract and / or bifurcate and / or reduce the contract work at any time without giving any notice to the Contractor without incurring any responsibility.

**24) GENERAL CONDITONS**

- a) The successful bidder has to ensure supervision of the work through duly qualified and competent persons and also has to make sure that a responsible Person is full time available on work site to whom **GMDC** can issue the instruction and who can fulfill such instructions.
- b) The successful bidder shall not change the constitution of the company/ firm during the currency of the contract.

- c) For any dispute arising out of this Work Order or interpretation of any terms thereof, the decision of **GMDC**, shall be final and binding upon the successful bidder.
- d) In case of any Central/State Government directives regarding execution of work related thereto, the same shall have to be strictly adhered to and shall be binding upon the successful bidder, for which **GMDC** will not be responsible for any compensation.

## **25) DISPUTES & JURISDICTION**

Matter relating to any dispute or difference arising out of this tender and subsequent contract award based on the bid shall be subject to the exclusive jurisdiction of Ahmedabad court only.

## **26) FORCE MAJEURE**

Force majeure is here in defined as natural phenomena such as floods, cyclone, earthquakes and epidemics, declaration of war, accidents etc. In such conditions of force majeure both the parties can claim force majeure but they are obliged to inform the either party within 7 days in writing of the date of commencing and again ending of the force majeure. Under the circumstances of force majeure, the contract terms of quantum of work and period shall be extended by period equivalent to the loss of time due to force majeure.

The decision regarding the occurrence of force majeure to be considered shall be taken jointly by Successful bidder and **GMDC**.

Period of such time loss due to force majeure will be considered for reducing the monthly target for calculating the liquidated damages for the respective month in which such force major has occurred.
