Chapter I

1 GMDC:

Gujarat Mineral Development Corporation Limited (GMDC), a Government of Gujarat Enterprise, is a pioneer organization in the field of mining for more than three decades, catering to the needs of the minerals and solid fuel for the industries based in and outside Gujarat. GMDC's mining activities are spread over in Kutch, Jamnagar, Bharuch, Baroda and Banaskantha districts of the State. It is currently dealing in minerals like Bauxite, Fluorspar, Ball Clays, Silica sand and Lignite. The Corporation has also 250 MW lignite based Thermal Power Station at Nani Chher in Kutch, The Corporation has annual turnover of about Rs. 1226 Crores,

In the year 1940 to 1950, Umarsar lignite deposit was initially explored by Geological survey of India at grid interval of 400 met X 400 met . Later on GSRC has carried out confirmatory exploration work as per requirement mostly on grid interval of 250 met X 250 met. The geological assessment was carried out on these exploration work and exploitation work was allotted to private mining contractor, During the actual mining work because of erratic nature of deposit and irregular thinning and thickening behavior of lignite seams some geological abnormalities were observed and as such re assessment of geological model with close space drilling (100 met X 100met) data has become essential.

2 DESCRIPTION OF THE WORK AND LOCATION :

The current exploration work is in existing lignite mining lease area of Umarsar, taluka Lakhpat of Kutch district

- c. On verification of the supporting documents, technical qualification of the bidders will be assessed. The bidders will be communicated the date and time of on line opening of price bids by fax or telephone or email or SMS. However, all the bidders will be able to view the price bids online on their computers at their place.

15. Preamble

- 15.1 This tender document is intended to give a general description of nature of the work and the quality envisaged for the material, workmanship and the finished product. It is not intended to cover all minute details. The work shall be executed in accordance with best drilling practices and to the complete satisfaction of the GSRC.
- 15.2 The information given in this tender document is given in good faith and meant to serve as a guide to enable the prospective bidders to submit their offer. It is, imperative that the bidders shall obtain and examine, for himself, all the data, information and particulars required for the satisfactory execution of the work covered under the scope of tender inquiry.
- 15.3 In the event the space provided in the tender forms is insufficient for the required purpose, additional sheets may be added. Each such additional sheet must be numbered consecutively showing the tender number and duly signed. In such cases, reference to the additional sheets must be made in the Tender proposal form.
- 15.4 Price bid will not be opened unless part I & II tender is complete in all respects and bidders is found to have adequate experience and resources for executing the Work. The price bid of only technically qualify bidders shall be opened.
- 15.5 The tender document and forms referred to in the tender, if not returned or if returned but not duly filled in and signed, will result in rejection of the tender.

16 Examination

- 16.1 The bidders shall carefully examine the tender document including all amendments/addendum and corrigendum, if issued, and other details relating to the work and acquaint himself fully with all the conditions and matters therein, which may, in any manner, affect the work and the cost thereof.
- 16.2 The bidders shall be deemed to have obtained all information as to risks, contingencies, responsibilities and other circumstances which might influence or affect his tender, the progress and performance of the contract and to have taken into account all conditions and matters that may affect his works under this tender and cost thereof.
- 16.3 The bidders shall be deemed to have visited the drilling site and its surroundings, carefully examined and satisfied himself about the existing site

conditions, availability of local facilities, means of transport, water etc. and to have quoted rates, taking into consideration all such conditions and matters, which may, in any manner, affect the work and the cost thereof.

- 16.4 The bidders shall be deemed to have acquainted himself with all Government, and Labour laws, statutes, regulations, rules or notifications relating to taxes, levies and other charges relating to the work at the site or otherwise as applicable from time to time. The rates quoted by the contractor shall not include any Government taxes, levies and other charges relating to his work at site as applicable from time to time.
- 16.5 Any neglect or omission or failure on the part of the bidder in obtaining necessary and reliable information upon the foregoing or any other matter affecting the tender, shall not absolve him of any risk or liabilities or responsibilities for completion of the entire work in accordance with the terms and conditions of the tender document.
- 16.6 Any conditional tender will be rejected outright and no claim whatsoever in respect thereof shall be entertained. The Management of GSRC reserves the right to reject / cancel any or all tenders without assigning reasons and to negotiate with any Contractor for more favourable rates

Each and every page of the tender proposal shall be signed by the bidder with his usual signature. All signatures should be dated and Company's seal shall be affixed below it.

- 17 GST : if applicable, will be paid/adjusted/reimbursed to the Contractor as per the prevailing rates and rules as per act to the extent directly related to the services rendered by the Contractor under the said contract subject to production of documentary proof and Contractor will mention the GST amount separately in the invoice/bill after considering the abatement, if any.
- 18 **Validity of the offer:**

The bidder agrees that the rate submitted shall remain valid for acceptance for a period of 180 days from the date of the opening of the tender.

Chapter No - 3

Other important instruction to Contractors

1 Location of bore hole :

GSRC will provide bore hole location plan , The Contractor has to fix up the bore hole on site In case the proposed borehole location are in private land, the Contractor has to make his own arrangement for drilling of borehole in private land. it is sole responsibility of the Contractor to drill the boreholes in private land

The Contractor has to make his own arrangement for approach road, availability of land, clear entry, exit and transit at the place of work/borehole location

2 Rate quotation of work

- a). The Contractor has to quote single rate for exploration in Rs. per running meters for all depth & formation in given price bids.

The Contractor shall quote rates inclusive of all applicable taxes except GST as per format of price bid.

Possible nature of rock type in the proposed exploration areas is lignite, different types of Clay , Shale , friable Sand Stone, Conglomerate & sandstone etc.

GST, if **applicable** and payable by the Contractor, shall be reimbursed by GSRC at actual subject to submission of documentary proof of having remitted / adjusted the GST and to the extent directly related to the services rendered by the Contractor under the contract. This shall be subject to submission of documentary proof clearly mentioning the name of work and respective RA Bill No.

Any other fresh imposition or variation in existing taxes or levies during the currency of the contract by the Govt. if applicable and payable by the contractor shall be reimbursement by GSRC at actual subject submission of documentary proof having remitted/adjusted the same and to the extend directly related to services render by the contractor under this contract.

- b). The evaluation of offers will be made on the basis of technical capability and the lowest offer received for the entire exploration work.

c) The GSRC reserves the right to accept or overlook or reject any lower offer and / or split the work between more than one Contractors without assigning any reason thereof .

The Contractor is required to quote the rate strictly as per the terms and conditions mentioned in the tender documents. **The conditional tender will not be entertained and will be rejected.**

The rates quoted by the bidders are firm and no escalation shall be given on any ground whatsoever in nature

3. ACCEPTANCE OF LETTER OF INTENT :

The GSRC, on acceptance of the offer , will issue LOI to the contractor , who will be require to confirm its acceptance of the LOI within two weeks from the date of its receipt. If it does not accept the letter of indent within stipulated time period , the amount of the EMD paid will be forfeited and necessary further action may be initiated as may be deemed fit by the GSRC

4. COMMENCEMENT OF WORK & DEVELOPMENT OF CAPACITY:

The Contractor will have to start the work within 15 (Fifteen) days of the date of receipt of the Letter of Intent, by deploying adequate nos. of Rigs and other machinery required to carry out the job and will have to develop full capacity within 30 days thereafter.

In case of failure to commence the work within 15 days from the date of receipt of the LOI or in failure to achieve the capacity as scheduled above, the contract may be terminated, at the discretion of GSRC resulting forfeiting EMD submitted by bidder.

5 CONTRACT AGREEMENT:

The contractors ,along with payment of security Deposit, shall have to enter into agreement with the GSRC on appropriate Stamp paper(to be provided by the contractor) as a taken of acceptance of the terms and conditions of the contract, within 10 days of submission of its acceptance of LO1.

In the case of any necessity arising after executing the agreement and during the execution of the work which requires alteration/notifications in the agreement, that can be made after mutual understanding and consent of Contractor and GSRC. The same shall be reduced in writing.

The contractor shall also indemnify GSRC against any claim, compensation, damage, loss, penalty etc for compensation, damage, loss, penalty etc for breach and/or non fulfillment of prevailing Rules and Regulations and other statutory provisions in force from time to time and applicable to the work during the currency of the contract.

6. GENERAL:

- a) GSRC will not be responsible for any postal delay whatsoever.
- b) If the tender documents and forms referred to in the offer are not submitted or are submitted but not found duly filled in and unsigned, will result in rejection.
- c) In the event of space being insufficient for furnishing required information, additional sheets may be used and signed.
- d) Canvassing in any form may lead to rejection of the offer.

7. GSRC reserves the right to reject any or all the offer or split the work between more than one Contractors without assigning any reason thereof.

Chapter - 4.

Qualifying Criteria

Experience

The Contractor should have following minimum experience of having successfully completed similar work during last 7 years up to 31/03/2017.

Three similar completed each work having total 4000 mtrs core drilling annually
or

Two similar completed each work having total 5000 mtrs. of core drilling annually
or

One similar completed work having quantity of 8000 mtr. of core drilling annually.

(Similar work means core drilling experience by hydraulic core drilling machines in any type of formation)

2. Possession of drilling machine

Minimum 4 nos of hydraulic drilling machine having capacity to drilled up to 100 mtr. along with required accessories. Contractor has to submit documentary evidence clarifying ownership of the drilling machine along with technical bid .

3. Technical employee

Minimum one Geologist having MSc/M.Tech degree. Contractor has to submit documentary evidence clarifying employment details of the Geologist with contractor/consultant along with technical bid

4. Average Annual turnover of the company in last three years

The annual average turnover of the company in last three years ended on 31/03/2017 should be minimum Rs 30 lacs and the Bidder has to submit audited balance sheet of these three years ended on 31/03/2018 years along with technical bid failing which the bid submitted by bidder shall be outrightly rejected.

- 6 The contractor shall have sound financial position so as to buy and deploy the additional machinery to meet the targets if required. Meaning thereby the contractor must have net worth equal to 30% of the cost of additional machinery in its audited balance sheet which shall enable the contractor to buy the additional machinery on award of contract if required. The certified copy of the balance sheet and documentary proof of the cost of machinery shall be attached with the technical bid

7 The Contractor should clearly state its status and submit duly attested supporting documents

8 Joint Venture:

Since , this is limited work of only 10,000 meters , No Joint Venture is applicable.

8 ACCEPTANCE OF GENERAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS:

The Contractor should unconditionally accept all the terms and conditions of the contract by signing on each page of the technical bid document of the tender including annexures.

9 EMD

The Contractor should enclose separate crossed demand draft in favour of GSRC payable at Ahmedabad from banks approved by Govt. of Gujarat from time to time (except Co-operative Bank) in the form and manner acceptable to the GSRC worth Rs. 2.50 lakhs (Rupees two lakh fifty thousand only) towards Earnest Money Deposit along with the documents of technical bid in the cover so super-scribed. In absence of the DD for EMD or inadequate amount of EMD, the offer will be rejected.

10 DECLARATION

The Contractor should give a declaration along with the technical bid that it has not enclosed any conditional offer.

11 BLACK-LISTING OF THE CONTRACTOR:

The Contractor should NOT have been not black listed by any Government Organisation, nor should any litigation should be pending against any of them. The Contractor will submit declaration to this effect along with the technical bid. If at any time such declaration is found false, the bid will be rejected or if the contract work is already awarded, it will be terminated forthwith without payment of any compensation and the EMD/SD will be forfeited.

CHAPTER – 5

Scope of Work

Gujarat Mineral Development Corporation (herein after referred to as GSRC proposes to carry out exploration work by hiring of Diamond core drilling rigs to explore in Kutch district with the following terms and conditions.

1 SCOPE OF WORK

1.1 Exploratory Drilling :

- (a) The Contractor will ensure availability of adequate numbers of hydraulic Diamond Core drilling rigs with necessary accessories and Manpower and other ancillary equipment for Exploratory core drilling with NX / BX size & Ax size if required.

The proposed drilling locations is lignite mining lease area of Umarsar lignite mines taluka Lakhpat of Kutch district

- (b) The drill holes will be Vertical.
- (c) **The drill hole depth will be varying from 20 meters to 100 meters.**
- (d) The core recovery in all the formation should be at least 85 %. This will not apply in loose sand or it's equivalent formation.

1.2 Survey Work :

GSRC will provide the proposed bore hole location plan of all the areas to be covered under exploration. and location (on plan & Field) of minimum two bench marks with RL and co ordinates within close proximity of area of Exploration.

The contractor has to make Its own arrangements to fix – up the proposed bore hole location on the site. They will also determine the Reduce Level and Co – ordinates of all the bore holes.

In case of the bore hole location shown on plan is not feasible on ground, the alternative location should be decided in consultation with GSRC Geologist.

1.3 Core Logging :

The Contractor shall adopt Standard procedures of Geological core logging which include details of Lithology ,Thickness, Grain size , Colour and Megasopic Characters and other related details.

The Water table observation of each completed bore hole and loss of Water if any during the drilling work should be part of the core – logging.

The Contractor has to submit all the original logging registers to GSRC after completion of the work.

1.4 Sampling:

The Contractor has to collect samples of all the economical minerals encountered during drilling operations

The lignite and Carbonaceous material samples would be packed in to polyethylene tubes immediately after drilling to avoid the loss of initial moisture. The contractor has to take initial In – situ moisture reading on the site ,. with help of suitable instruments.

There will be one lignite / limestone sample for every 1 meter run of lignite / limestone seam thickness. Each sample should be crushed in desirable mesh and after conning & Quartering final sample should be prepared.

The selected recovered core and sludge shall be arranged properly in wooden core boxes of 1 m long with 6 riffles covered with wooden lid . Each run shall be marked properly by Plastic tag and the core boxes shall be numbered properly .The contractor will have to make arrangements for core boxes at his cost. The Contractor will hand over all the collected samples and selected core Boxes to GSRC at desired location for further Physical , Chemical and Geo Technical analysis work.

The sampling should be carried out in presence of site Geologist .

1.5 Bore hole depth :

Maximum depth is 100 meters and bore holes will be drilled up to older formation or may be closed as per the instructions of Site Geologist.

1.6 Exploration Report :

The Contractor has to Submit exploration report (3 hard copies and 1 soft copy (i.e. CD)) in following documents :

1. Key plan
2. Location of B/H on cadestal plan / lease plan
3. Lithologs of the drilled boreholes.
4. Table – A showing concise lithology of all the bore holes.
5. Table – B showing OB thickness , IB thickness and lignite thickness along with lignite to OB ratio.
6. Reserve Calculation as per UNFC and related map
7. Analysis data frequency distribution.(Results will be provided by GSRC)

The Contractor has to submit final exploration report within two months period after submission of full analysis data from GSRC

1.6 GSRC responsibility :

To provide bore hole location plan

To provide analysis data for all collected samples during exploration work for exploration report writing work

The Contractor responsibility : In addition to above scope of work following are additional responsibilities

In case the proposed borehole location are in private land, the contractor has to make his own arrangement for drilling of borehole in private land. it is sole responsibility of contractor to drill the boreholes in private land

The Contractor has to make his own arrangement for approach road, availability of land, clear entry, exit and transit at the place of work/borehole location

The Contractor has to provide weekly/monthly progress report and respect of drilling and sampling.

After completion of drilling contractor have to seal (plug) each borehole and shall construct and erect pillars of standard sizes with borehole number.

Site preparation supply of diesel, lubricant, tools tackles drilling machineries, transportation of manpower to the drilling site, lodging and boarding

2. General scope of Services :

The Contractor shall mobilize all the equipment's for the drilling within the time schedule.

The Contractor shall deploy his own manpower for the satisfactory completion of the entire scope of work

The Contractor shall make his own arrangement for shifting the drilling rigs to new location / site at his own cost.

The Contractor shall arrange the wooden core boxes for preserving the core at his own cost.

The Contractor shall make his own arrangement for diesel , Lubricants , all other consumables , power , Camping , Transportation Etc. .

3 DURATION AND QUANTITY OF WORK

(a) The period of the contract and quarterly target will be as Under

c) Total drilling should not be more than 10,000 meters

However GSRC reserves the right to increase or decrease the quantum of the work with advance intimation to the contractor.

GSRC reserves the right to split the work between more than one Contractors without assigning any reason thereof.

4. RATES:

(a) The Contractor has to quote single rate for exploration in Rs. per running meters for all depth & formation in given price bids. **The contractor has to quote rates inclusive of all applicable taxes except GST as per format of price bid.**

(b) Rate quoted shall remain valid for 180 days from the date of opening of the technical bid, which shall have to be extended unconditionally for further maximum of period 60 days, as deem fit by GSRC

- c) The firm rate quoted by the Contractor shall be valid for the entire currency of the contract. No escalation in the rates will be allowed on any account.
- (e) **The rates quoted by the bidder shall be free from corrections and over writings. Tenders containing over writing, erased rate(s), corrections or illegible rates shall be liable for rejection.**

5 EARNEST MONEY DEPOSIT :

- (a) A non-interest bearing Earnest Money Deposit of Rs. 2,50,000 /- (Rupees two lakh fifty thousand only) shall be paid along with the tender, and enclosed with **Technical Bid** documents in seal cover superscribed "**TECHNICAL BID**", in form of Crossed Demand Draft in favour of GMDC Science & Research Centre. payable at Ahmedabad from Nationalised or Scheduled bank (not being Co-operative). Or

Bank Guarantee issued by Nationalised or IDBI,ICICI, Axis, HDFC banks only in India valid for a period of not less than 3 (three) months beyond the proposed contractual period of six months.
- (b) Any pending dues against invoice or any other deposit lying with the GSRC will not be adjusted against Earnest money deposit, Any tender submitted without Earnest Money shall be summarily rejected and no claim shall be entertained on such rejected tenders.
- (b) The Contractors will be refunded the EMD amount by way of crossed cheque within 15 days of finalisation of the tender. In case of Bank Guarantee the same shall be returned in original.
- (c) The EMD of the Contractors (the Contractor) shall either be adjusted as a part of security deposit, if desired by the Contractor or shall be refunded by way of crossed cheque on receipt of security deposit amount
- (d) If the contractor does not accept the work order issue by GSRC then EMD amount paid by the Contractor will be forfeited.

6 SECURITY DEPOSIT

- (a) The Contractor shall pay security deposit @ 5% of the total contract value in the following manner.
 - i. 2.5% of the total contract value (including EMD) before the commencement of the contract work in form of a Crossed Demand Draft in favour of GSRC. payable at Ahmedabad or a Bank Guarantee, from banks approved by Govt. of Gujarat from

time to time (Except Co-operative Bank) in the form and manner acceptable to the GSRC.

- ii. The balance 2.5 % amount of the Security Deposit will be recovered from Contractor's Running Account Bills by deducting it at a rate of 5% of RA bill amount and built up till the full amount of SD is realized
- b) Security deposit shall not bear any interest.
- c) It shall be refunded to the Contractor, within a period of three months after satisfactory completion of the work and removal of equipment, tools tackles, camp site etc, and the due fulfillment of all the terms and conditions of the contract including submission of final exploration report. The Contractor shall obtain a certificate to this effect from the General Manager [Project] / Project-in-Charge Site Geologist and shall submit the same to the General Manager [Geo] at Ahmedabad who after verification of the fact will arrange for refund of SD.
- d) GSRC will reserve the right to recover the charges or the penalty from the Security Deposit in the following circumstances-
 - i. If the Contractor or its employees causes any damage or destroy any property belonging to GSRC / GSRC .
 - ii. The shortfall amount of all compensations, penalties and other sums of money payable by the Contractor or recoveries to be made under the terms of this contract which is due but not paid by the contractor in full , etc.

7 RUNNING ACCOUNT BILLS.

The Contractor shall submit the monthly Running account bills **for completed Bore holes** only to Head office GSRC with following documents .In no case bill for uncompleted bore hole will be made.

- I. Detailed Joint measurement & computation sheets, duly signed by Geologist of Contractor and Site Geologist / Project Manager of GSRC.

8 MODE OF PAYMENT

90% payment will be made from GSRC Head office after submission of Monthly Running bill.

The final 10% payment will be released from Head Office after submission of Exploration Report

The Running Account bills, submitted at Head Office will be processed, after considering following deductions.

- a) Income tax as per provision of Income Tax Act, and other Taxes (and sur-charges) applicable in force from time to time
- b) Security Deposit @ 2.5% of the gross amount of the RA bill as per clause No.2
- c) If any amount becomes payable by as a result of any claim or application in terms of the provisions or non compliance of provision of the any Acts and the Rules and Regulations, By-laws or the Orders made there under, applicable from time to time , such amounts shall be recoverable from the bidder for which GSRC will not be responsible for any compensation
- d) Liquidated damages or penalty if any.
- e) Any other applicable deduction & statutory deductions.

9 LOCAL FACILITIES / LOCAL CONDITIONS

- a) GSRC do not undertake and agree to provide any facilities to the Contractor at the work site. However, the Contractor have to make its own independent arrangements.
- b) The tools, tackles, machinery, equipment, pumps etc. and the manpower required to execute the contract shall be arranged by the Contractor only.

10 STATUTORY OBLIGATIONS:

- a) The Contractor shall be responsible for arranging requisite manpower, and shall also fulfill the provisions of Labour laws, Contract Labour Laws etc if applicable
- b) If any amount becomes payable by GSRC as a result of any claim or application in terms of the provisions or non compliance of provision

of the any Acts and the Rules and Regulations, By-laws or the Orders made there under, applicable from time to time , such amounts shall be recoverable from the contractor for which GSRC will not be responsible for any compensation.

- c) The selected Contractor shall also indemnify the GSRC against any claims, compensations, damages, loss, penalty etc. for breach and / or non-fulfillment of the prevailing Rules and Regulations and other statutory provisions in force from time to time and applicable to the work during the currency of contract.

11 MEASUREMENTS

Measurements of quantum of work (i.e in meter) drilled by drill machine will be carried out in presence of an authorized representative of the contractor and Geologist at site in charge deputed from GSRC for look after the entire work and will also certify the same.

This measurement shall be final and binding to the contractor.

12 LIQUIDATED DAMAGES(L.D.)

1. If the Contractor fails to mobilize the machinery and manpower to commence the work within (15) days of receipt of LOI, liquidated damage @ Rs. 10,000/- per day shall be leviable, for a maximum period of 15 days. If the Contractor fails to start work even after 15 days, the GSRC will be free to take any action including forfeit of EMD and termination of LOI at your cost and risk.

The Liquidated damages shall be leviable after end of every month on the shortfall in the quantity of meterage to be drilled specified in respect of that month target, counted from the date of commencement of work till the relevant RA Bill period, at the following rates

- a) The obligation to strictly comply with the specified monthly quantity i.e. the quantity specified in respect of the particular month in the monthly schedule is fundamental requirement and obligation of the Contractor.
- b) Shortfall in the targeted quantity shall be reviewed on cumulative target basis at the end of each running account bill period so that the Contractor can recoup and recover the shortfall, if any, during the month of the respective RA bill period.
- c) **The GSRC reserves right to terminate the contract and get the balance work completed at the cost and risk of the Contractor if cumulative short fall is found more than 20% for three consecutive months/ RA bill period**

13. Corrigendum :

Corrigendum if any shall be display on website www.nprocure.com only. Please note that there is no provision to take out the list of parties downloading the tender document from the above referred website. As such Contractors are requested to see the website once again before due date of tender opening of ensure that they have not missed any corrigendum uploaded against the said tender after downloading the tender document. The responsibility of downloading the related corrigenda, if any, will be that of the downloading parties.

No separate intimation in respect of corrigendum will be sent to Contractors who down loaded the tender document from websites as information in this respect will not be available to websites.

14 NON FULFILMENT OF TERMS & CONDITION AND TERMINATION OF THE CONTRACT

- 14.1 If the Contractor fails to carry out the work as per terms and conditions of the contract to the satisfaction of the GSRC, GSRC shall be entitled to forfeit the security deposit paid by the Contractor. This however, shall not absolve the Contractor from his obligation to fulfill the contract. In such event, the GSRC shall have a right to complete and / or to get the work completed at the cost & risk of the Contractor and the Contractor shall be responsible to pay such cost incurred by the GSRC to complete the work and / or to get the work completed.
- 14.2 Likewise, if the Contractor does not fulfill the terms and conditions of the contract and does not carry out the work up to the entire satisfaction of GSRC, GSRC has the right to forthwith terminate the contract at its sole

discretion, without assigning any reason, Under such events, the GSRC shall be entitled to forfeit the security deposit paid by the Contractor and the GSRC shall have a right to complete the work and / or to get the work completed at the risk and cost of the Contractor.

- 14.3 For any reasons, if it is required, the GSRC reserves rights to cancel terminate. amend and / or alter the contract and / or bifurcate and / or reduce the contract work at any time without giving any notice to the Contractor and without incurring any responsibility. For such cases, Contractor shall have to take away his labour, tools, tackles, machinery, equipment etc. and shall leave the site at once or shall have to carry out the instructions of the GSRC.

15 ARBITRATION

All questions, disputes , differences whatsoever which may at any time arises between the parties to this tender and subsequent contract or any matter arising out of or in relation thereto, shall be refereed to Sole arbitrator as per the provisions of Arbitration and Conciliation Act. 1996 the venue of the arbitration proceedings shall be at Ahmedabad only. The language of the Arbitration shall be in English.

16 JURISDCITION

The matter relating to any dispute or differences arising out of this tender and subsequent contract based on the bid shall be subject to the exclusive jurisdiction of Ahmedabad only.

17 FORCE MAJEURE

- 17.1 Force majeure is herein defined as any cause which is beyond the control of the Contractor or the GSRC as the case may be which they could not foresee or with a reasonable amount of diligence could not have foreseen and which substantially affect the performance of the contract, such as:

- i. natural phenomena such as flood, draughts Cyclone, earthquake and epidemics, declaration of war.
- ii. Acts of any government, including but not limited to war, declared or undeclared priorities, quantities, embargoes, providing either party shall within fifteen (15) days from the occurrence of such a cause notify the other in writing of such cases.

- 17.2 The Contractor will advise, in the event of his having resort to this clause by a registered letter duly certified by the statutory authorities, the beginning and end of the cause of delay, within fifteen days of the occurrence and cessation of such Force Majeure condition. In the event of delay lasting over two months, if arising out of Force Majeure, the contract may be terminated at the discretion of the GSRC.
- 17.3 For delay arising out of Force Majeure, the Contractor will not claim extension in completion date for a period exceeding the period of delay attributable to the causes of force Majeure and neither company nor the Contractor shall be liable to pay extra costs (like increase in rates, remobilization, advance, idle charges for labour and machinery etc.) provided it is mutually established that the Force Majeure conditions did actually exist.

If any of the Force Majeure conditions exists in the place of operation of the Contractor even at the time of submission of bid he will categorically specify them in his bid and state whether they have been taken into consideration in their quotations

- 17.4 The Contractor of the GSRC shall not be liable for delays in performing his obligations resulting from any force majeure cause as referred to and/ or defined above. The date of completion will, subject to hereinafter provided, be extended by a reasonable time given though such cause any occur after Contractor's performance of his obligations has been delayed for other causes.

18 TERMINATION OF THE CONTRACT

In case of Contractor's failure to carry out the work to the satisfaction of GSRC as per terms of the contract, GSRC can at its sole discretion, terminate the contract and/or forfeit the Security Deposit. This will, however, not absolve Contractor from the obligation to fulfill other terms and conditions of the contract. In such a case, the Contractor will have no right whatsoever to claim any compensation for the same. The decision of GSRC in this regard shall be final and binding upon Contractor.

In case of any changes in the directives of Central/State Government regarding mining operation / and execution of work related thereto, the same shall have to be strictly adhered to and binding upon Contractor/ Contractor for implementation and GSRC will not be responsible for any losses suffered by the Contractor as a result of such changes.

GSRC may terminate this contract at any time during by giving seven days notice to the Contractor without assigning any reason whatsoever.
