

**CORRIGENDUM No.- 1 Dated.23/03/2018**

Ref: Tender No: LP/02/17-18

**WORK:**

- The Work of Removal of Overburden/Interburden by excavation, transportation to dumps and related ancillary activities.
- The Work of Excavation and Loading of Lignite into dumpers from mine face and related ancillary activities.
- The Work of Transportation and unloading of Lignite –
  - i. Raw lignite from mine face to Pyrite removal plant/Stack Yard and related ancillary activities.
  - ii. Processed lignite from Pyrite removal plant to Stack Yard and related ancillary activities.
- Loading of-
  - i. Lignite into consumer's truck from Lignite Stack yard by deploying excavator/loader.
  - ii. Bentonite into consumer's truck from Lignite Dump/Stack yard by deploying excavator/loader.
- De-watering of rain/seepage water from the pit bottom by installing the adequate numbers of the SS pumps (Electrical/Diesel) and required all accessories to carry out the pumping operation.

### **CLARIFICATIONS**

1. No Escalation on Work Component for all works as per condition prevailing in the tender document.
2. Landing price of diesel at the project shall be considered for payment of diesel component as per condition prevailing in the tender document.
3. Evaluation will be made on the basis of total amount of all the works as mentioned in the tender document.
4. Extra Flow meter to be kept at the site and replaced in case of break down for measuring the quantity of discharged water.
5. No compensation or payment shall be made as per clause no.1.6 of Part-II of Ch-V of tender document in the tender document, in case of conclude/postpone/complete/terminate/foreclose of the contract.
6. No payment will be made for dewatering the water from small sump at surface level as per provision in the tender document.
7. Weighbridge is located on the route of pyrite plant and as such not necessary to go for additional lead for weighbridge.
8. Work shall be carried out in three shift of 8 hours and rest day of the workers may be staggered and work may be continued all the seven days of the week.
9. During the monsoon, targets will not be assigned and LD is not imposed. Contractor can carry out the works during dry spell in the monsoon and payment for the work executed may be made.
10. GMDC reserves absolute right/discretion to reject any or all the tenders received or invite fresh bid at any stage or split the work between one or more bidders as the case may be.
11. Mine is in operation but the working area is different and hence the contractor has to make necessary illumination arrangements as per provision in the tender document.
12. The quantities of the works may increase/decrease as per actual requirements and bidder has to consider the same as per provision in the tender document.
