RFP FOR PROCUREMENT OF SERVICES FOR DRONE SURVEYING AND MAPPING OF EXISTING AND UPCOMING MINING PROJECTS

1. Clarification regarding LIDAR

LIDAR sensor/camera is not mandatory to carryout the assignment /work. Further please refer clause no. 3 (sensor / camera specification and output data resolution) of part I of final SOP published by IBM , Nagpur

2. Section – II Clause No. 1/Part-3/(k)

Original Clause :

The Agency shall generate the volumetric and extent analysis reports for each and every mining site (as listed in Annexure 12) in GMDC and ensure that accuracy to be achieved is at 100%

This clause Deleted.

3. Section – II , Clause No. E page No. 13 –

Schedule of Drone Survey

Original Clause:

“ Except first year drone surveys shall be conducted for all mines of Group – 1 as mentioned at annexure – 12 for a period of three years from 1st April to 15th May, and for all other mines and new lignite blocks of Group -2 for one year only...”

Modified/Amended Clause

“ The drone surveys shall be conducted from 1st April to 15th May for all mines of Group – 1 as mentioned at annexure – 12 for a period of three years, and for all other mines and new lignite blocks of Group -2 for one year only.”

4. Section – III Clause No. 1/1.3/(i)/a

Original Clause:

“The minimum qualification requirements for Joint Venture: The qualifying criteria parameters e.g. experience, financial resources etc. of the individual partners of the JV will be as deliberated under clause 8 of section III of the RFP towards fulfillment of qualification criteria related to the experience.”

Modified/Amended Clause

“The minimum qualification requirements for Joint Venture: The qualifying criteria parameters e.g. experience, financial resources etc. of the individual partners of the JV will be added together for the relevant period as deliberated under clause 8 of section III of the RFP towards fulfillment of qualification criteria related to the experience.”

5. Section – III , Clause No. 6/ 6.1/(b) –

BID EVALUATION CRITERIA

Original Clause

“The Bidder must have an average annual turnover of **Rs 50 Lacs** (Rs Fifty lacs) per annum in last three financial years ending on 31st March 2021 i.e. 2018-19,2019-20,2020-2021.

Documents Required :

- Audited Balance sheet
- Profit & Loss statement
- Certificate of statutory auditor certifying turnover of the bidder for the 03 (three) preceding financial year i.e. 2018-19,2019-20, 2020-2021
- Income Tax returns for the preceding three assessment years, i.e. 2019- 20 and 2020-21, 2021-2022.

Modified/Amended Clause

“ The Bidder must have an average annual turnover of **Rs 50 Lacs** (Rs Fifty lacs) per annum in last four financial years ending on 31st March 2022 i.e. 2018-19,2019-20,2020-2021, 2021-2022.

Documents Required :

- Audited Balance sheet
- Profit & Loss statement
- Certificate of statutory auditor certifying turnover of the bidder for the 04 (four) preceding financial year i.e. 2018-19,2019-20, 2020-2021,2021-2022
- Income Tax returns for the preceding three assessment years, i.e. 2019- 20 and 2020-21, 2021-2022.

6. Section – III- Clause no. 6/6.1/ (C) –

Original Clause:

“The bidder should have a minimum strength of 10 (ten) professionals (mining engineers/geologist, surveyors and software experts) having 3 years or more experience on its payroll (non-contractual staff) who have the relevant experience in the drone mapping, geo-spatial dash boarding and surveying sector. (Surveyors must have the requisite competency certificate from DGMS). Additionally, the Bidder shall commit to deploy any special domain area experts in mineral and mining sector as required for this engagement without any additional cost.”

Modified/Amended Clause

“The bidder should have a minimum strength of 10 (ten) professionals (mining engineers/geologist/geomatics, surveyors and software experts) having 3 years or more experience preferably on its payroll who have the relevant experience in the drone mapping, geo-spatial dash boarding and surveying sector. However, the successful Bidder shall have to deploy surveyors having requisite competency certificate issued from DGMS. Additionally, the Bidder shall commit to deploy any special domain area experts in mineral and mining sector as required for this engagement without any additional cost.”

7. Section – III - Clause 6 /6.1/e

Original Clause

“Bidder should produce evidence of having experience of successfully completed similar works for minimum 3000 **Hect.** during last three years.....”

Clarification :

The similar work such as
drone survey of mine/ water/road/irrigation/canal/dam will be considered.
