RFP for Selection of Drilling agency for undertaking Soft Rock Exploratory Drilling Activities

New clause added / inserted

Clause No. 3.6 under clause No. 3 section III.

“Clause No. 3.6 - Concession to MSME registered units.

Exemption from submission of RFP fees/EMD shall be given to bidders who are Micro, Small & Medium Enterprises (MSME) and are registered under provisions of the Policy i.e. National Small Industries Commission (NSIC). To qualify for RFP Fees/EMD exemption, firms should necessarily enclose a valid copy of registration certificate issued by NSIC which is valid on last date of submission of the RFP documents.

The following procedure is adopted for the MSME bidders registered with NSIC:

1. Bidder shall produce documentary proof for exemption of RFP fee and EMD.
2. The bidders who intent to claim benefit under MSME Act, shall fulfill the following, otherwise they run the risk of their bid being passed over as “INELIGIBLE” for the benefits applicable to MSME and their bid will not be considered for evaluation.
3. MSMEs which are specified by the Ministry of Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises under MSMED Act 2006 and Public Procurement Policy, 2012 as Manufacturing / Service Enterprises should have registered with NSIC under its Single Point Registration Scheme (SPRS)
4. NSIC certificate with monetary limit indicated should be valid on the scheduled date / extended date of submission of tender. Certificates without monetary limit will not be considered.
5. The items of Product / Services mentioned under NSIC certificate should be the same or similar to the tendered/RFP items (Schedule of Quantity of Tender)

6. The monetary limit stipulated in the NSIC certificate of MSMEs should be equal or more than the value of work(s) / Supply is / are “In hand (progress)” awarded under MSME benefits during the financial year plus cost estimated by you of this RFP for availing RFP fees/EMD exemption.
7. If monetary limit is less than the value of work(s) / Supply is / are “In hand (Progress)” awarded under MSME benefits during the financial year plus cost estimated of this RFP, they should obtain “Competency Certificate” from NSIC for participating in this tender as well as to avail MSME benefits. The competency certificate should be submitted separately.
8. MSMEs shall submit the declaration as per the proforma attached in Annexure “MSME” duly attested by Notary Public.

However, no exemption for submission of Performance Bank Guarantee granted to MSMEs and has to be submitted by successful MSME bidder under any circumstance.”
