- ◆ Interactive session with Coal Block Allottees of 6th tranche of auction by Ministry of Coal at New Delhi



In order to secure India's energy needs, the Ministry of Coal held interactive session with allottees of commercial coal mines on 12th April 2023. The session was chaired by Sh. Amrit Lal Meena, Secretary MoC, Sh. M. Nagaraju, Additional Secretary & Nominated authority.
