
Business Operations

GMDC led by MD Shri Roopwant Singh, IAS, is advancing in Odisha with plans for a 4400 MW power plant and key community projects, including a Sports Complex, Hospital and Schools. With discussions underway with the Odisha Government, GMDC is committed to driving sustainable growth and socioeconomic development.



GMDC successfully received the Allocation Order from the Ministry of Coal for its third Coal Mine "Kudanali Lubri" in Odisha signifying our commitment to responsible mining practices and contributing to the nation's energy landscape.

The public hearing for environmental clearance of Gujarat Mineral Development Corporation's (GMDC) proposed 15 MTPA Baitarani- West coal project was successfully held recently near the Jagannath temple in Chhendipada. Affected villagers participated in large numbers, expressing strong support for the project. The hearing was chaired by Angul's Additional District Magistrate, Pratap Pritimaya, and conducted by Dr. Ramesh Kumar Ekka, Regional Officer of the State Pollution Control Board, Angul. Swagat Ray, GM of GMDC, presented an overview of the company, the project's benefits, and environmental protection measures. GMDC plans to invest Rs4,445 crore in the project, which will generate 1,752 direct jobs, with priority given to local residents, along with thousands of indirect employment and business opportunities. Environmental monitoring and extensive tree planting will help minimize pollution. Villagers welcomed the project, calling for employment priority and increased Corporate Social Responsibility (CSR) spending for the area's development. GMDC assured the community of its commitment to improving socio-economic conditions through CSR and reducing environmental impact using the latest technology. The meeting was attended by local leaders, including Chhendipada MLA Agasti Behera, Sarpanch Sudipta Pradhan, and senior company officials, including Chief General Manager H.K. Joshi and project heads. The coal project will be developed across Chhendipada Jungle, Handigoda, Podapada Jungle, Machhakuta, and Tentuloi-Kodasahi areas.
